Public Programs

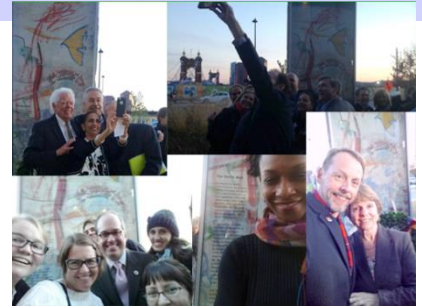
