Cincinnati – Greater Cincinnati World Affairs Council will host German Ambassador to the United States, Peter Wittig. The ambassador will discuss trans-Atlantic relations during this meeting, which will conclude with a Q&A session.

Ambassador Wittig has extensive knowledge concerning international issues, which is the focus of this event. He has a long history with the United Nations, having previously served as German Ambassador to the UN in New York, and was a German representative during Germany's tenure as a member of the UN Security Council. Aside from the UN, Ambassador Wittig has served as a private secretary to the Foreign Minister in Madrid, was an Ambassador in both Lebanon and Cyprus, and was the German Government Special Envoy on the "Cyprus Question" (the division of Cyprus).
