Public Programs

GCWAC served 350 business, academic, and civic leaders in 2011 through coffee and conversations, luncheons, dinners, and foreign policy discussions.

Topics included US and Canadian Relations, Veterans Day, Iwo Jima, Business Protocol and Culture in Brazil, US in Iraq and the Kurdistan Region, Ending Iran's Quest for Nuclear Weapons, Egypt and the US, and NGO Management.

US Department of State International Visitor Leadership Program

In 2011, 259 international visitors came to Cincinnati and met with over 165 local professionals or organizations. The visitors stayed in local Cincinnati hotels for 1,268 nights and many of the Cincinnati community members hosted dinners for the visitors. For this program, there were about 3,800 volunteer hours logged.

GlobalCincinnati.org

The international online portal for businesses, organizations, experts, and events has been officially launched for one year. The FREE international resource for all of the Greater Cincinnati community has nearly 60 international businesses, over 160 international non-profits, nearly 40 international experts, and a daily updated calendar of international events.

Kindergarten – Adult Education Programs

In 2011, the Greater Cincinnati World Affairs Council served over 500 students, teachers and adults in the Greater Cincinnati region through the annual international education programs. Programs range from student simulation events like Model APEC to the day long International Education Summit where students focus on an international topic for a day and meet international professionals throughout the Cincinnati region. Partnerships with organizations like the University of Cincinnati and the Foreign Policy Association allow us to reach adult students as well through the longest running international education program in the country, Great Decisions.
